

Hedgerows are needed to ensure that wildlife such as songbirds, hedgehogs, pollinators, invertebrates etc. have a place to live and thrive.


Trivia: If all the Manx Hedgerows were laid end to end it would reach all the way to Canada.

In contrast the Isle of Man has 1099 kms of public roads.




AVERAGE FIELD SIZES
